The Department of Human Development was established in 1977, following the founding of the Balwadi in 1974 by pioneers like Madam B. Tarabai and M. S. Subhalakshmi. The department offers a B.Sc. in Human Development, addressing the contemporary need for expertise in this field, as emphasized by government five-year plans focusing on child and women welfare programs. Various NGOs collaborate with the department to enhance its impact.

The syllabus is updated every three years to enhance students' abilities, align with current job opportunities, and meet global demands for better societal integration. The curriculum includes subjects such as Personal Empowerment, Early Childhood Care and Education, Guidance and Counseling, Learning in Early Years, Child Psychology, Child and Family Welfare, Children with Special Needs, and Management of ECCE and Welfare Centers. Theoretical and practical knowledge equips students for their careers. The department also runs the Zaverba Balwadi nursery school and daycare center.
