

1. Demonstration of use of Ergo Master Software and Anthropometric kit: (27.06.2014) the Ergo-Master Software is the recent advancement in ergonomics. The demonstration for the software was requested from ELTEK SYSTEMS and Dr. Nidhi Bansal occupational therapists from Mumbai. The Anthropometric kit and Goniometer was purchased from the same vendor and so requested to demonstrate that also. The demonstration was carried out in the presence of department faculty members and final year students of FRM.





2. **Workshop on Flower Arrangement: (23.07.18 to 24.7.18):** A workshop was organized for the second year students of the college where flower arrangements for various occasions were demonstrated by Dr. Devika Thakkar and Ms. Kalpana Srivastava and later students were asked to practice for the same.
